



***Update: Corbin McNeill's complaint against The Boulders' Owner***

At the Pre-Trial Conference yesterday, Friday, September 27, the Honorable Judge Stephen McNamee reviewed the proposed case management plan and set the schedule, rules and obligations of both parties for the proceeding litigation.

Corbin and his team are very satisfied with the ruling and dates. There is a lot of work ahead for them but they are confident in their approach.

As a result of yesterday's conference, discovery now begins and Corbin can file motions as soon as his lawyers are prepared. They anticipate this to be on or about October 11th.

We are now planning to delay the ZOOM Town Hall Meeting until after the motions are filed, as Corbin believes you will want to know more about them. Watch for our announcement of the day and time for the ZOOM Town Hall Meeting.

When the court's scheduling order is issued, we will post it on the BMA website and notify you.
